THE BLACK DOG

Locally loved pub, set on the Pleasure Gardens. Rotating Cask-Marque accredited real ales, world and craft lagers and a carefully selected wine list.

BEER: EAGLE IPA

Beavertown's any day, any time, easy drinking IPA. A light, crisp and punchy, go to beer.




TAMESIS DOCK

Enjoy like you're on a beach in Portugal. Pale golden in colour it has a crisp, dry character and pleasant refreshing bitterness.




ZEITGEIST
